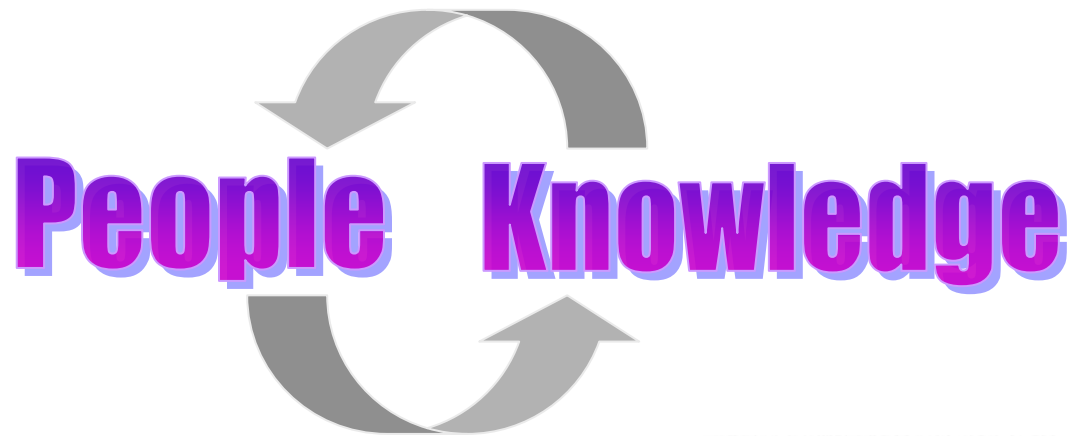

- Collecting relevant information to share



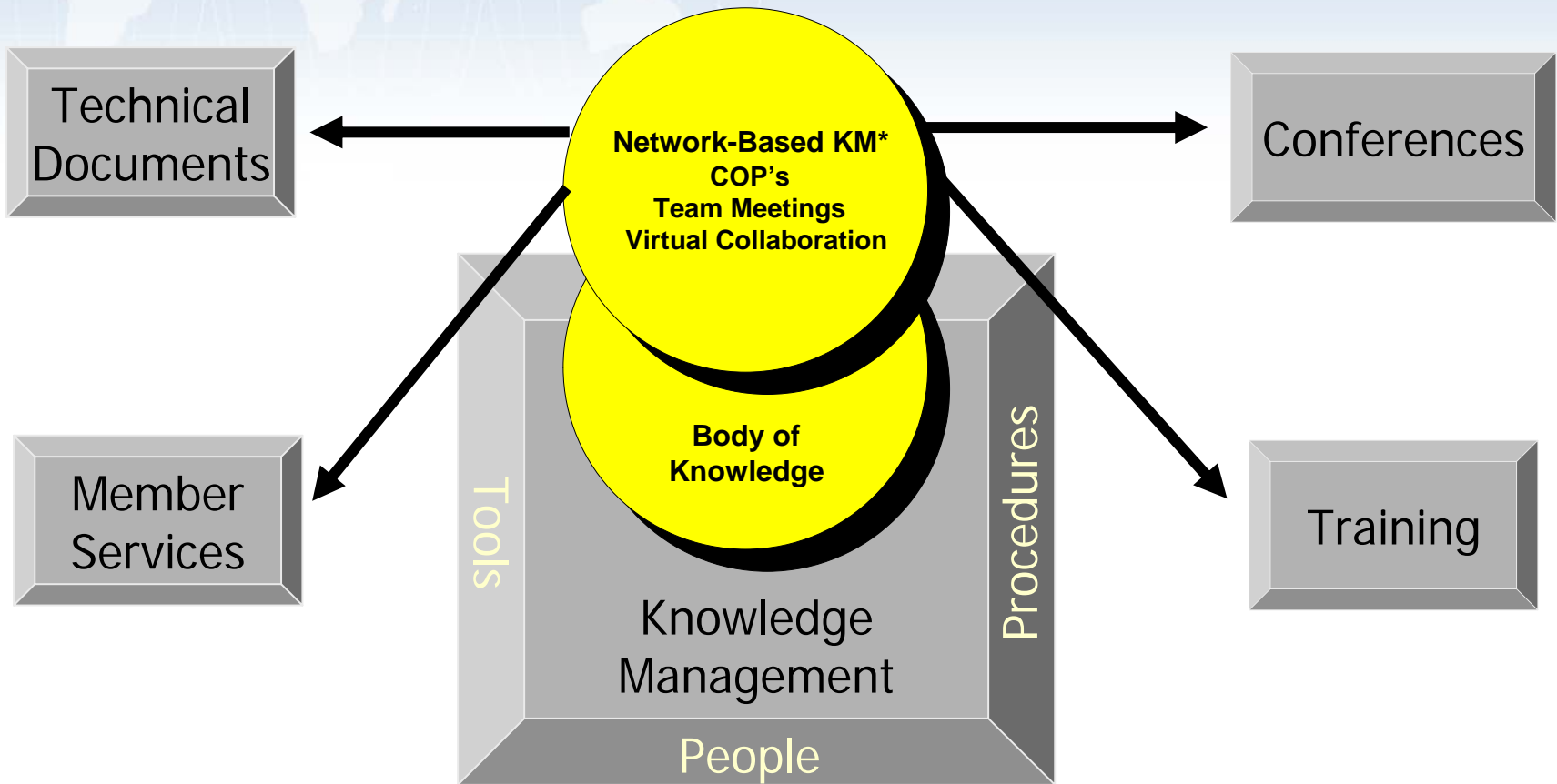
# ISPE COMMUNITIES OF PRACTICE

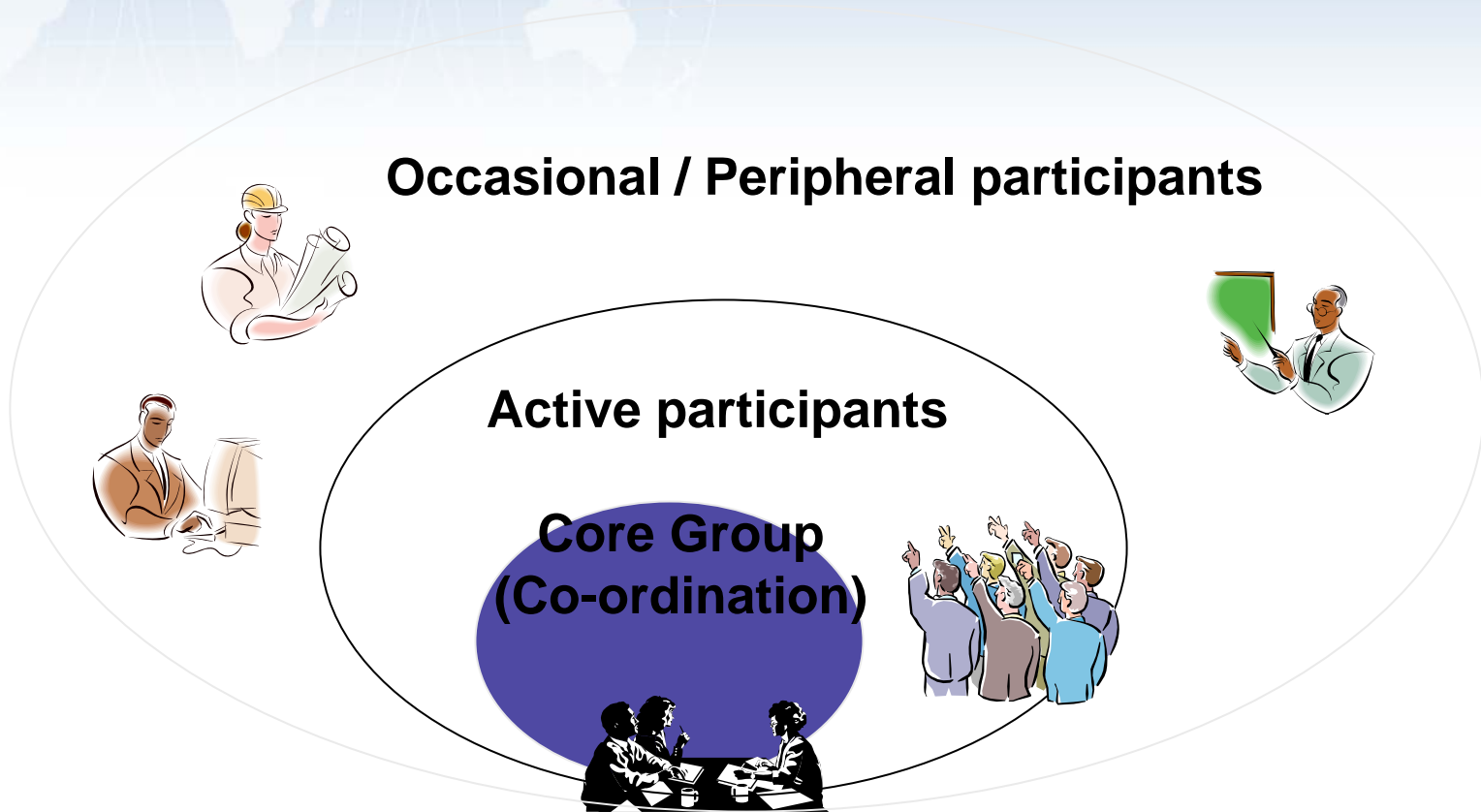
# Value to Community Members
